An important fact about all languages is that they change in the course of time. The English language as it was used about thousand years ago (called old English) was quite different from the English that is used today; and the English was used about seven hundred years ago (called middle English) was again different both from old English and from Modern English. If you read something written by Shakespeare, about 400 years ago, you will notice many things about its language that were normal in those days but would sound strange in present day English. Old English changed, gradually, into middle English, which also changed, in course of time into Shakespeare's English; and this changed again, over four centuries into present—day English. 


