- What is really wanted today is a different orientation towards history of the people as a whole, which will go for its sources not only to historical documents but to literature, folklore and the arts. This means an extensive study of the Indian languages and their older forms. Emphasis on the importance of describing the social and cultural life the past is significant of the approach to history which brings to nearest to life by describing the economic and social forces that motivated history. The traditional historian was prone to the purely nationalist view of the past so that it often happened that the English school boy heard only of his country's victories and the French boy only of England's defeats in war. It was this sort of bias that has resulted in politics being regarded solely as the pursuit of power and encouraged such doctrines as those of fascism. The temptation of the historian to elevate his country or his province at the expense of others is always great, and in India which seeks to maintain its unity it is particularly important that people should not become obsessed with notions of superiority based on biased histories.
