Science not only provides knowledge about nature; it also provides means for controlling nature. So, besides general ideas, science also affects practical affairs and everyday life. Perhaps the most obvious example concerns transport. Up to the end of the 18th century, transport on land differed very little from what it had been in Roman times. A Roman officer in 2nd century Britain could get from London to York as quickly and comfortably as an 18th century English gentleman. Owing to compass and to improved design of ships, sea-transport had improved a little, but not very much. Then came the invention of the steam-engine which was dependent on the general scientific knowledge of the time, and its improvement by science. Steam-ships and railways with stem-locomotives completely changed the business of travel and of the transport of goods.
