## Admission Procedure

Admissions are made on merit basis and as per the rules, regulations and norms laid down by the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad, Director of Education, Government and management.

### Admission Guideline

- Application for admission to the college should be made on a prescribed admission form by all the students including those who were in this college during the previous year. This is to be done immediately after the declaration of the result of the pertinent examination of the previous year.
- The Prescribed form and prospectus can be obtained from the College Office. The admission form, completed in all respects and accompanied by requisite documents should be submitted to the college after the declaration of the result of the qualifying examination. The list of requisite documents to be attached to the admission form is described in the next section. The admission forms which are incomplete or incorrectly filled or submitted late will be summarily rejected.
- Out of the total available seats for each stream 50% seat will be reserved for those belonging to Jain Minority Community. Reservation for the remaining 50% Seat will be as follows : SC- 12%, ST-7%, VJ-3%, NTI -2.5%, NT 2 - 3.5%, NT 3 - 2%, OBC- 19%, SBC - 2%. Reservation is applicable only for Maharashtra domicile SC, ST, DT, NT, OBC, SBC. Categories as per the Government of Maharashtra G.R. [The students migrating for other states will not be entitled to the concessions/benefits available to the SC/ST/DT/NT/SBC & OBC Students of the Maharashtra State.]
- Non-creamy layer certificate is necessary for DT/NT/OBC/SBC category candidates at the time of final admission. If the candidate is not domicile of state of Maharashtra then he should submit the domicile certificate.
- Candidates from Maharashtra state belonging to SC/ST/DT/NT/OBC must submit the caste validity certificate. Three percent seats of total sanctioned intake capacity shall be reserved for physically handicapped candidates out of these seats one percent each is sanctioned for Blind, Deaf & Dumb and orthopaedic disorder.
- The admission forms will be scrutinized by the college office. A merit list will then be drawn on the basis of the marks of the qualifying examination and put up on the notice board.
- The admission forms of the students who have secured admission on the basis of merit list will be signed by the appropriate authorities. The grant of admission to the class rests solely with college authorities.
- The admission granted by the college is provisional until it is confirmed by the appropriate authorities.
- It should be noted that the fees paid will be treated as deposit till the admission is confirmed by the authorities. If later on the admission is rejected by the University or cancelled by the student the fees will be refunded with deductions as per the rule of the Education Dept.



- Student to be eligible for the first year of degree course must have passed the H.S.C. Examination or an examination recognized as equivalent with subject as may as Specified by the university in relevant streams.
- photocopies of the following document duly attested by a competent authority should be submitted along with the admission form filled in by the applicant in neat the legible handwriting.
  - [I] Statement of Marks (Last qualifying examination)
  - [ii] Statement of Marks (Last qualifying if statement of marks does not indicate clearly class/percentage of marks obtained by the student in the relevant returned)
  - [iii] Migration certificate (original) (if applicable) (Original will not be returned)
  - [iv] Transfer Certificate, (if applicable). (Original will not be returned)
  - [v] Written Statement regarding gap in education and/or change of name (in the admission process by the college / university.)
- All the original document except leaving certificate / transfer certificate / migration certificate / gap certificate, etc. will be returned to the concerned student after the same are stamped by the college for scrutiny.

### **FREESHIP / CONCESSION IN FEES**

The following remission / concession in fees is available at this college

- 1) Students whose parents - guarding have an income less than Rs. 100000/- par annum are eligible for E.B.C. Concession provided that they belong to Maharashtra The student coming from other states are not eligible for this E.B.C. forms should be submitted in the College Office in duplicate duly filled in all respects, signed and stamped by a Special Executive Magistrate / Officer at the time of admission.
- 2) Freeship for the Sons / Daughters of Primary School Teachers.
- 3) Government of India Scholarship is awarded to the B.C. students. The students applying for the Government of India B.C. Scholarship for the last academic year should submit their forms duly filled, in all respects within 30 days of the admission of before 31st July or whichever is earlier. No application will be accepted after 31 st July. The following document should be attached along. with forms:
  - a) Income Certificate (if Parents / Guardian is Government Employee}.
  - b) Income Certificate from Tehsildar, if parents / guardian are in private service.
  - c) Caste Certificate.
  - d) Form of undertaking.
  - e) Adhar card .
- 4) Scholarships for the physically & orthopedically handicapped student. :



- 5) Government of Maharashtra Open Merit Scholarship.
- 6) Concession for the children of Freedom Fighters.
- 7) The Government of India Merit Scholarship.
- 8) National Loan Scholarship.
- 9) National minority Scholarship.

**Note :** EBC, BC, PTC /DP, Girls Declaration and other concession should be submitted along with the admission forms. Forms submitted later will not be entertained.

### **Cancellation of Admission**

The candidate cancelling his/her confirmed admission will be entitled to receive the refund of fees after deducting the amounts as indicated below except otherwise prescribed by the State Govt. /University/Competent Authority.

## STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

### Student Council:-

It is constituted as per the Maharashtra University ACT 1994, section 40 and activities are run for the welfare of students. There is a democratically elected student's council in the college. All regular student of college are the members of the student council which function under a cell. The council of the student regulates the activities of the council including election and formation of the executive committees of the council. The council is pledged to uphold the dignity and high academic ideas of the college.

### Gymkhana:-

In College we provide the facilities to student who are more active in sports. We give special attention on indoor and outdoor games. We have established dominance in Basketball And Volleyball, Chess and Cricket tournaments. We conduct Yoga camp and also encourage female student for their participation on order to inculcate the habit of physical exercise among the student. Facilities for extracurricular activities fitness center, 200 mtr running track, ground for outdoor sport like cricket, football, volleyball, kabaddi, kho-kho are available. We have large playground which we use for Handball, volleyball, badminton, kabbadi, and cricket practices. Sports students are given preference on admission. We give scholarship for sport students as per the recommendation of the physical director. Student participate free of cost. We host tournaments in our campus on behalf of university and other sports associations.

### Library:-

The Library is centrally placed and easily accessible. It has holding of ground (10,000) books. It Subscribe to more than 20 National and International journals. Sufficient numbers of books are purchased every year to update the library and satisfy the growing needs of the students. Reference Book, encyclopaedias, books for competitive examination, newspapers and newspaper clippings are available for the students. The library has been partially computerized. There is separate reading hall for the student with essential amenities. The book bank has been instituted for the needy and hard- working students. We appeal to the donors to donate books and funds to the book bank. It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that in view of the judgement order dated 11.02.2009 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of the University of Kerala V/s the council of Principals of College in Kerala and others, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of Anti Ragging Committee the accused students will be given an opportunity to explain and if his/her explanation is not satisfactory the college authority would expel him/her from the college.
